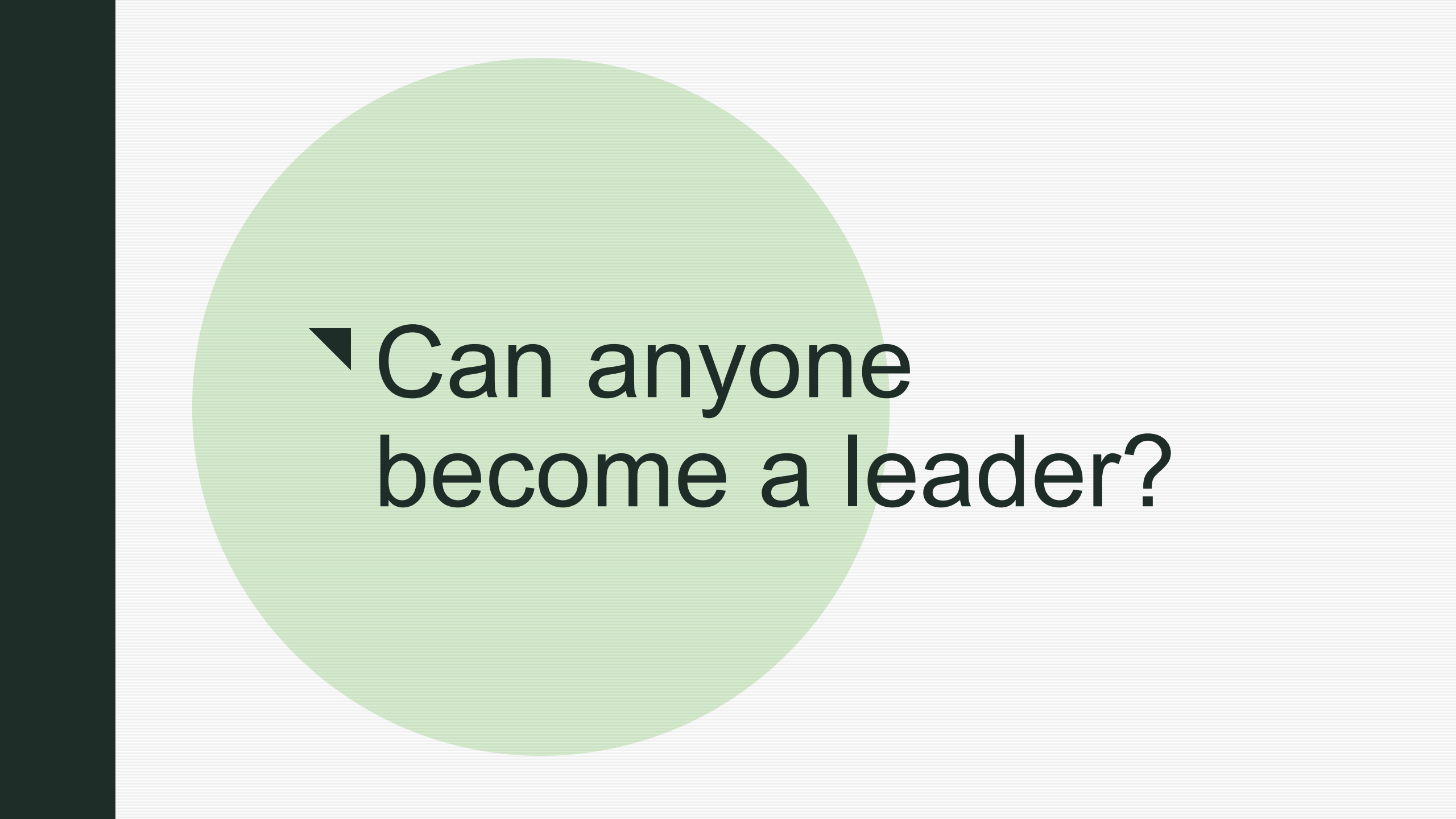


1. Defining Leadership

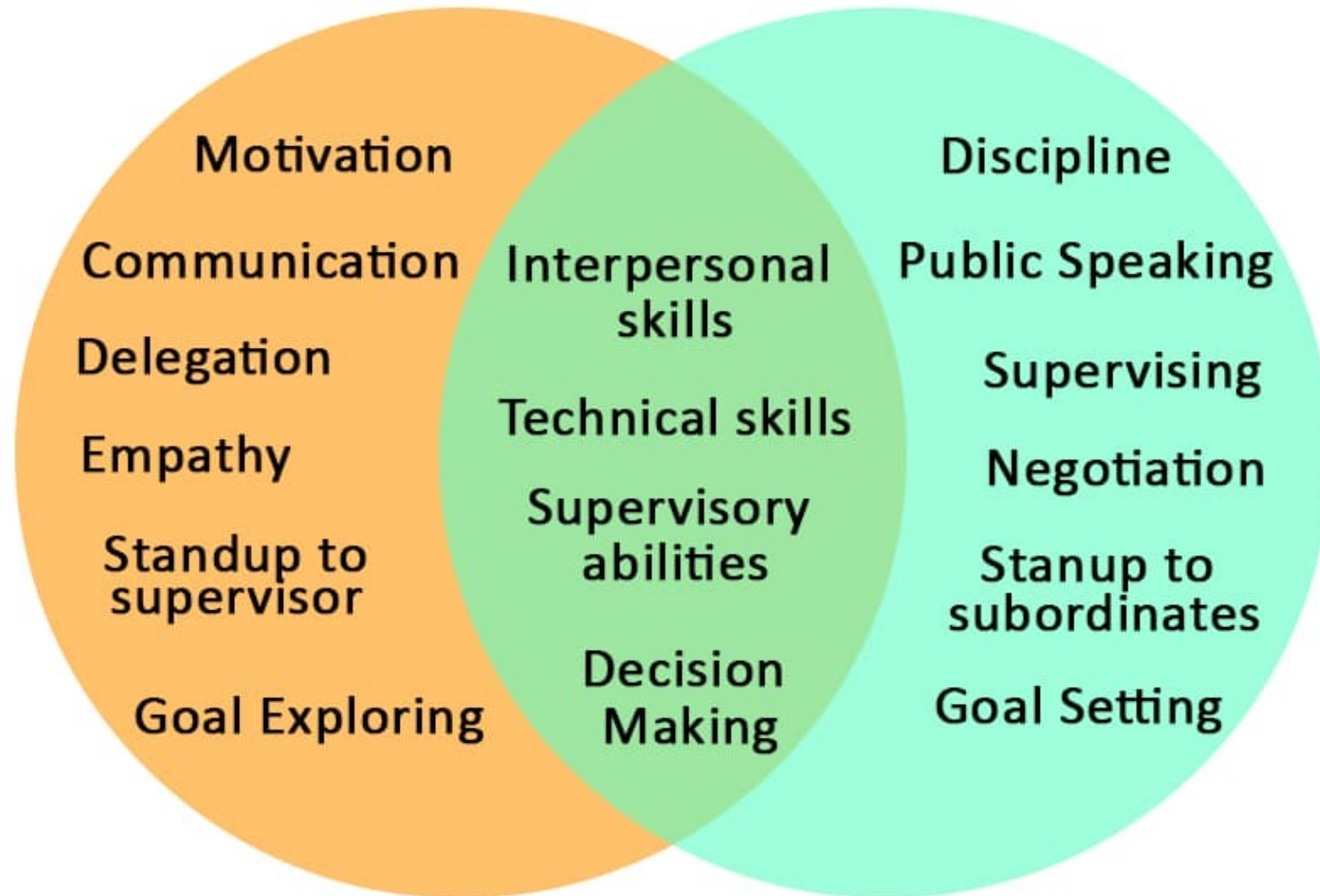

3. Types of Leadership

1. Transformational – One who has vision...sees what the future needs to be and pulls the future into the present with a team of people.

3. Types of Leadership

2. Laissez-faire – “allow to do”...a leader who allows others to lead as they wish...not hands-off in a negative way, but rather one who trusts his/her team.

3. Types of Leadership

3. Democratic – One who loves to work in teams...allows subordinates to speak into decisions...focus on team over.

3. Types of Leadership

4. Autocratic – One who is the singular decision maker...pushes others to greatness, so long they do things his/her way...is often isolated.

3. Types of Leadership

5. Servant-Leader – One who view himself/herself as a slave as the Most High God...serves while leading and leads while serving.
