

How to increase the quality of your videos by adding cinematic movements

Every camera movement should be intentional and used to express emotion.

Avoid Handheld

- Bad handheld footage reminds the viewer there is a camera. It is our goal to express the emotion of the scene and have the camera be invisible.
- There are times that call for a "handheld" shot, but there are tools and techniques to use to get that look. Don't go straight handheld if you can help it.
- Use stabilizers
- · Still shot > bad handheld
- If you have to go full handheld, use at least three points of contact and stabilize as much as possible

Depth/Foreground

 When moving around your subject, place elements in the foreground to accentuate that movement





Motivated Movement

- Movement for no reason can seem jarring.
- In order to fix this, we can do something like follow someone through the scene to get to another person.






Rack Focusing

 Rack focus from something far away to something up close or viceversa
